Our Vision for Quest and Youth Ministry

Here at St. Francis Xavier Parish, we are excited about our ministry to our high school age parishioners. This ministry is facilitated through the efforts of many people. Our parents and many other adults in the community interact with youth and have an impact on the growth and development of teens, particularly in the area of Christian values. The ministry that takes place here at St. Francis Xavier Parish provides opportunities for our youth to develop relationships with many different adults in the context of youth and parish. Out of these relationships we envision the possibility of faith development, community building, mentoring, and of course, fun.

The high school students who wish to be confirmed are invited to participate in the Quest Confirmation Program from September through April. Those seeking Confirmation are asked to participate in four elements of parish and faith life in preparation for this important sacrament.

Sunday Eucharist (on a weekly basis)
Service Opportunities (two with group & one with sponsor)
Quest Home Group Meetings and Speaker Events
Quest Lenten Teen Reconciliation Service (March 11)

Quest Home Group Meetings are a gathering of groups of teens with adult leaders. These gatherings, in the homes of adult facilitators or at the parish, provide opportunities for relationship building, discussion on issues facing teens, service opportunities, growth in the understanding of scripture, and *fun*.

The four elements of our Confirmation preparation process are provided for the candidate's benefit and growth in faith. They are not meant to be an obligation that places heavy burdens on a candidate. Rather, we hope that these opportunities will facilitate a candidate's sense of faith and belonging to the Catholic faith community. This is a process of growth and maturation that takes time. Each high school student reacts uniquely to this type of preparation process.

Some will move through this entire process in their freshman year of high school; others may do so over several years. The program is open to high school students of <u>all</u> ages. Therefore, a freshman may choose to do certain elements of the program in freshman year and continue with the remaining portions in subsequent high school years. For example, if a candidate does not attend Mass on a regular basis when entering the program, he/she may choose to focus on developing this practice and to participate in the Reconciliation Service in freshman year; they may then focus on Service Opportunities and Quest Meetings in sophomore, junior, and/or senior year before receiving the sacrament of Confirmation.

The most important of the four elements of the process is weekly participation in Sunday Eucharist (Mass). This is a basic element of practicing Catholicism and nourishes all that we are and do as Catholics. The celebration of Confirmation for an adolescent implies a Catholic teen who is aware of the meaning of Catholicism itself and committed to regular participation in Sunday Eucharist.

Candidates who have completed all four elements of the preparation process are asked to complete a formal application for the sacrament of Confirmation. This happens in March, in the final weeks of preparation for Confirmation. Those who want to apply for Confirmation but who are unable to fulfill all four elements of the process are invited to meet with the Pastor or his representative before March 6th.

Registration Fee:

We ask each Confirmation candidate to pay a registration fee of \$45 to offset the cost of the program. This fee supports the cost of materials and resources for our leaders, speaker events, and Confirmation liturgies. Each candidate will receive a copy of Decision Point, which is the primary resource for the Quest Small Groups.

How to Choose a Sponsor

Some items to consider when deciding whom you will ask to sponsor you on your journey toward becoming a confirmed Catholic Christian:

- 1. Notice which of the Catholic Christians you know exemplify for you what it means to be a full, active member of the Catholic Church.
- Consider someone with whom you are comfortable developing a relationship as you move through the Confirmation process; with whom you will be willing and able to talk about what you are learning about yourself, others, God, and Church; someone who will help you recognize your gifts and encourage you to use them.
- Consider someone who can be available to you through the Confirmation process, not just on the day of the Confirmation ceremony. You will be asked to engage in at least one service activity with your sponsor.
- 4. One of the godparents at your Baptism may also serve as the sponsor for Confirmation. <u>Neither</u> of your parents cannot serve as your Confirmation sponsor.
- 5. Sponsors need to meet all of the following three requirements:
 - ✓ The sponsor is sufficiently mature to serve in this role.
 - ✓ The sponsor is a member of the Catholic Church who has received all of the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist).
 - ✓ The sponsor leads a life in harmony with the faith and teachings of the Catholic Church.
- 6. Invite your sponsor to a meeting for Confirmation candidates and their sponsors on **Sunday**, **November 5**, at 5:00 PM, and to the Rite of Enrollment that will take place at the 6PM Mass following the meeting.
- 7. Give your sponsor the Confirmation Sponsor Commitment Form, which must be returned to the parish office **before November 5, 2017**.

Confirmation Sponsor Information

Things you can do:

- Ask your candidate about the Quest Speaker Events and Group Service Opportunities.
- 2. Encourage your candidate to be present and participate in the events.
- 3. Come on Sunday, November 5th to a 5pm meeting with your candidate, followed by the Rite of Enrollment at the 6pm Mass that evening.
- Assist your candidate next March in completing his/her application for the celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation.
- 5. Attend the Confirmation practice in church on Friday, April 20th at 7pm for the 10am Confirmation celebration and 8pm for the 2pm Confirmation celebration (candidates will be assigned to a specific time in January). Confirmation is April 21st for all candidates who have met all aspects of the preparation process and have submitted the application for the celebration of the sacrament of Confirmation.
- Pray for and with your candidate. Attend Mass together whenever possible.
- 7. Engage in a service opportunity with your candidate.
- 8. Take an active interest in the overall life of your candidate.
