

Pastor's Letter

"You are witnesses of these things."

Luke 24:48

These are among the final words of Jesus to his disciples in Luke's gospel. Jesus promises to send the Holy Spirit upon them; then he ascends into heaven. We might be tempted to think that these words are addressed only to the first disciples. Yet Christians across the ages have come to understand that Jesus gave this mission to <u>all</u> who come to believe in him, in <u>every</u> time and place.

How can we be witnesses to what we have not seen with our own eyes? The Risen Jesus did not appear to us as he did to his first disciples. We have not seen him with our eyes or heard his voice with our ears. We have not dined with him or walked the road as witnesses to his teachings and healings.

And yet, have we not been witnesses to his presence and working among us? Have we not listened to his words spoken to us through the gospels and dined with him as he shares his Body and Blood with us in the Eucharist? Have we not paused to recognize him in our loving service to our sisters and brothers in need? And have we not seen his face in the faces of those we serve?

For the past several years, Cardinal Cupich has called us to reflect on our work as *missionary disciples*. As much as the first disciples, we are called to give witness to what Jesus has done: for us in our personal and communal lives; and for <u>all</u> humankind. We are not meant to be passive recipients of the gospel, the Eucharist, or the gifts of the Spirit. We are called to allow these gifts to come to life in us and through our outreach to others. We do this through providing food, clothing, and shelter to those in need. We do this when we speak out on behalf of <u>the dignity of each person</u>: from the moment of conception to the moment of natural death and <u>in all moments</u> in between. More immediately, we do this by consciously and consistently giving life to our beliefs in our relationships with family and friends. We disciples do not need to travel to foreign lands to be missionaries. Our mission is first and foremost to the women, men, and children we encounter in each day.

I thank Jessica Chia, Owen Famulari, and Dominick O'Brien, three of the ten people who were fully initiated into the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. Last weekend, each of them gave witness at one of the Masses to their journey toward a relationship with Jesus and membership in our faith community. I also thank all the men and women who participated in our winter Alpha session, and the high school teens who participated in a similar program geared to them. Maggie McMahon and our parish Evangelization Team will offer our next adult Alpha session and teen program this fall. They also will be developing ways to bring the gifts of the Alpha experience into ongoing faith sharing and renewal within all parish ministries. The Holy Spirit will give us all that we need to heed the call of Jesus to go out as disciples in mission and share his story and how it shapes our lives.

If you are reading this before noon on Sunday, come on down to Joyce Hall (the lower level of the Education Building) and enjoy some pancakes and sausage. Our local Knights of Columbus Council is sponsoring this **Pancake Breakfast** to benefit various ministries that serve the other-abled in our area. All are welcome!

Your Gift, God's Hands Offertory Report

Through March of the Fiscal Year

Total Sunday and Christmas Collection: \$1,378,399

Targeted Offertory Budget based on 5% increase: \$1,367,000 (See Note 1)

Total Collected through March Last Year: \$ 1,314,977

Total Annual Offertory Budget: \$ 1,846,000

Our OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults) candidates were asked to share reflections after the homilies at all Masses last weekend. In her reflection, Jessica Chia shared, "It is very hard to get filled up if you don't go to the well. Leading up to our Confirmation, we heard a homily on the reading of the woman at the well. Maggie McMahon asked all of us in OCIA if we felt like the woman at the well, and I thought, no, I feel like the bucket! Yes, I was this bucket, and each time I came to Mass, or our Tuesday night gatherings, I was getting filled up, whether I expected it or not. There were times when I barely made it on time, or was distracted, and every single time, I was blessed. I was blessed hearing the testimonies of others, I was blessed by the prayers of our priests, I was



blessed by the fellowship and encouragement of so many of the parishioners here at Saint Francis. It is nearly impossible to get filled up if you don't go to the well, but it is almost as impossible not to get filled up if you do!"

Note 1: The budget was approved based on a 5% offertory increase over last year and the use of about \$90,000 in parish savings to cover the budget deficit. Through March, our offertory is running close to the budgeted 5% increase, and we are still projecting a \$90,000 deficit. Easter Collection is reported below and is not included in the March figures. Fiscal Year is 7/1/2023 - 6/30/2024


End of the Year Fundraiser


