The At Home Lesson for January 27 and January 30 was emailed to families yesterday, January 24 AND AN alternate lesson this morning. PLEASE take the time to go over this sensitive topic with your child(ren) and/or use the alternate lesson which is also a safety lesson. The lessons are taken from the Child LURES" Program. I received both support for yesterday's lesson that was emailed and concerns about the lesson through calls and emails. A ROBO call went out yesterday afternoon explaining that the reason for sending the lesson by email was so that it did not get in the hands of children and, therefore, you can present the topic in the way best appropriate for your family. We are expected to cover topics from that program each year. I will NOT address either safety topic on February 10/13. I was only going to ask children to always remember the guidelines that parents give their children to help them keep safe. Nothing more would have been said, however, I will not address either topic at all. No paper work is asked to be returned. Thank you for taking the time to keep our children safe.
