Well, the Ground Hog was right! Winter is here to stay for a while. We are scheduled for Religious Ed this Sunday. Please check your email by 8:00 on Sunday morning if that should change. Unfortunately, there is a glitch with our School Messenger Account and, therefore, we need to rely on email communication with you if we need to close. Please do not call the office. Parents are asked to use your discretion on whether to send your child(ren) if we remain open.

Second grade will meet with Fr. Bill Tkachuk on Sunday and Wednesday as they get ready to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time; third graders will meet with Fr. Bill Tkachuk in preparation of their second phase of celebrating this sacrament, and our Sixth Graders have their Mass at Noon on Sunday. Three very good reasons why we want to stay open! Snow, snow.....go away......we have so much to do this Sunday!

Wednesday is Ash Wednesday. Children attending RE on Wednesday afternoon and evening will receive ashes during a service during class time. The afternoon service at 4:15 is also open to children who attend Sunday morning RE but must be

accompanied by an adult. Sunday morning children will not be sitting in church with their class so an adult accompanying them is necessary. Ashes will also be distributed in church during the 7:45 and 9:00 morning Masses, at a 12:15 Prayer Service, and again at the 7:00pm Mass. Children always have the right of way. Be considerate of our neighbors on Waiola and Spring Avenues.
