We are still getting inquiry about registration. PLEASE remind your friends and neighbors to get their children registered NOW! Unfortunately, their first choice is probably not going to be open.

It has always been a goal of mind to work with parents and children to make Religious Education fit into our busy schedules. As mush as I want our children to participate in other activities, leaving early on a regular basis is disruptive.
