PICK UP PROCEDURES

Kindergarten parents ONLY may walk their child into the building.

WEEKEND MASS SCHEDULE

Saturday: 5:00 pm Sunday: 7:30 am, 9:00 am, 10:30 am, 12:00 noon, and 6:00 pm Wednesday will receive ashes at a prayer service during class time on that day. Sunday morning students are welcome to come to the afternoon service which will be at 4:15 in church. Sunday students need to be accompanied by an adult to that service.

Ash Wednesday, will find the parking lots open. PLEASE be aware of children walking thru the lots IF you use that space for parking.

The parish bulletin has information about all of the opportunities offered to parishioners this Lent. Make sure you pick up a bulletin after Mass this weekend.

Rice Bowls (CRS)

Lent is a time for prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. One way to put this into practice is by giving to the Catholic Relief Services. Students and their families are encouraged to do with a little less for one meal a week and put what would be spent on that meal in the Rice Bowl. Children are also encouraged to put in the Rice Bowl whatever would be spent on a candy bar, ice cream treat or pop if any of those are being given up for Lent.

Eucharistic Prep Liturgy

The second Eucharistic Prep Liturgy for children and their parents who are preparing for First Communion in May is scheduled for this Sunday, February 24 at 1:30pm in church. This is your Mass for the weekend. Children who come to class on Sunday morning still have class.
