This is coming to you with information regarding registration for the 2021-2022 School Year. St. Francis Xavier Parish will once again be offering **AT HOME CATECHESIS**. The safety and health of all of our families is very important to us, and therefore, we have decided once again, NOT to have students gather in the Education Building next school year. More info as to the format AND any possible changes will come once the new Coordinator of Religious Ed is hired. If you recall, Fr. Bill had asked me to delay my retirement for one year so we could journey together during this unprecedented COVID-19 school year. A Search Committee is being formed and you will hear more from the new hire later this summer.

Tuition for next school year will remain the same as this year:

Tuition of \$240 per family with
Sacramental fee of \$65 for First Eucharist,
\$40 for Fourth Grade Reconciliation and
\$20 Bible fee for sixth graders

A simple registration form is included with this mailing. PLEASE return as soon as possible AND PLEASE REGISTER for At Home Catechesis to keep your child(ren) on track with Religious Education. It is especially important to keep your child(ren) on track to receiving the sacraments. DO NOT include your upcoming freshman on the enclosed registration form.
