Pastor's Letter

Dear friends in Christ,

As we continue our journey together into the season of Ordinary Time, I'd like to begin by recalling that in my March 1 bulletin article, I noted that the parish was in a "period of discernment, listening to groups throughout our church, school, and Religious Education program, and to the Holy Spirit, or course!" I'm pleased to share with you that in next weekend's bulletin we will formally introduce an updated multi-year parish vision statement entitled ***Continuing the Vision***. This renewed prophetic plan has grown out of prayer, consultation and conversation during the discernment period. The parish staff and members of our Parish Pastoral Council look forward to sharing *Continuing the Vision* with our entire parish community in the coming weeks.

Many parishioners may remember the original prophetic plan developed for St. Francis Xavier from 2012 to 2016. That vision served as a powerful statement of our parish mission and helped guide many important accomplishments in parish life. In 2017, the parish revisited that vision, reflecting on the progress that had been made, and reaffirmed that it continued to express the heart and direction of St. Francis Xavier parish. Now with the arrival of a new pastor, the opportunities presented through the Archdiocesan capital campaign, and the importance of periodically assessing parish life and planning intentionally and carefully for the future, the parish undertook a more in-depth assessment with the assistance of a professional consultant.

One of the most encouraging outcomes of that process was the realization that the vision and spirit of St. Francis Xavier remain very much alive and well. In many ways, this new plan is not about changing who we are, but about continuing to grow into who we have always been called to be: a welcoming, vibrant, faith-filled parish community centered on beautiful and meaningful worship, strong relationships, active service and the flourishing of faith for generations to come. *Continuing the Vision* will help us move forward intentionally as we seek to address both the spiritual and material needs of our parish family, including future plans for expanded school and meeting space, renewed parish facilities and continued investment in the life and mission of our community.

As we prepare to share this vision more fully next week, I invite you to continue praying for our parish and for the guidance of the Holy Spirit. The story of St. Francis Xavier parish is a remarkable one, built through the faith, generosity and the dedication of generations before us. Now it's our turn to continue building upon that legacy with hope, gratitude and confidence in the future God is preparing for us together.

Friends in Christ,

I would like to inform you that our beloved Berghaus pipe organ is currently out of service as it undergoes necessary electrical repairs. This current repair process is expected to be extensive and will take some time to complete.

While the absence of the pipe organ will certainly be felt, especially given its rich role in supporting our worship and elevating our liturgical celebrations, I am grateful to share that a temporary replacement organ has been installed next to our Yamaha grand piano and will be used throughout this repair period. This instrument will allow the music ministry to continue providing musical leadership for our Masses and services without interruption.

I ask for your patience and understanding during this time of transition. Sacred music remains an essential part of our communal prayer, and while the sound may be different for awhile, our purpose remains the same: to glorify God and deepen our worship together through good Sacred music.

I will keep all of you updated on the progress of the repairs and look forward with great anticipation to the return of the Berghaus pipe organ in full voice.


