## Pastor's Letter

Dear parishioners and friends,

This weekend, on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of the Lord, we are pleased to share with the parish the updated St. Francis Xavier strategic plan *Continuing the Vision*. This new document reflects months of prayer, consultation and conversation about the future of St. Francis Xavier Parish. It has included the feedback and guidance of many representing every aspect of the SFX family. More importantly, it's an expression of our gratitude for the generations of parishioners who have gone before us, and whose faith and sacrifices have made our parish the vibrant community it is today.

Since the establishment of the parish in 1890, the people of St. Francis Xavier have worked tirelessly to build a parish that is welcoming and inclusive, centered on beautiful worship, committed to forming disciples, educating young people, serving those in need and fostering a strong sense of community. ## **PATHWAY TO “CONTINUING THE VISION”**

St. Francis Xavier has ministered to the La Grange area for over 135 years. The Parish has always had a strong foundation of faith, service, and community, which continues leading us today. In the 2010’s, the parish underwent a period of discernment, from which emerged the Prophetic Plan, with specific goals to guide us on our journey of missionary discipleship.





## **GOALS & OBJECTIVES**

*The following priorities represent the next phase of the Prophetic Plan, building upon the same values and mission that have guided St. Francis Xavier for many years.*

---

### **1. Deepen Lifelong Faith Formation and Spiritual Renewal**

- Create more welcoming and approachable opportunities for people to talk about faith and life.
  - Strengthen small groups and faith communities where people can support and encourage one another in their faith journey.
  - Provide retreats, prayer experiences, and spiritual renewal opportunities that facilitate a personal relationship with Jesus.
  - Support deeper participation in the liturgical and sacramental life of the Church.
- 

### **2. Strengthen Youth, Young Adult, and Family Re-Engagement in Parish Life**

- Develop meaningful pathways for youth, young adults, and those who have drifted from parish life to reconnect with the St. Francis Xavier community.
  - Expand youth ministry and young adult opportunities that foster belonging, faith formation, and renewed engagement in parish life.
  - Strategically position warm, welcoming invitations and opportunities around points of “re-connection” with families (e.g., marriage, baptism, and other life transitions).
  - Empower young people and returning parishioners to take leadership roles within parish ministries and community life.
- 

### **3. Strengthen Parish Engagement and Volunteer Pathways**

- Create clear and welcoming opportunities for parishioners to become involved in ministries, service, and parish life.
- Expand volunteer leadership and encourage broader participation across parish ministries and activities.
- Foster a culture where parishioners feel a shared sense of responsibility for the life and future of the parish.
- Help parishioners identify and use their gifts and talents in service to the parish and wider community.
- Encourage ministry leaders to mentor and develop future leaders.
- Create a culture of personal invitation, welcome, and hospitality for new volunteers and parishioners.



## 4. Strengthen Collaboration Between Parish Ministries

- Foster deeper connections between all parish ministries, including the school and the Religious Education program.
  - Develop shared parish experiences for the school and Religious Education families.
  - Promote greater collaboration among ministry leaders and parish staff.
- 

## 5. Invest in Professional Parish Leadership and Staff

- Ensure that all parish ministries (including church, school, and Religious Education) are led by qualified professionals.
  - Provide professional parish leadership and staff ongoing training, professional development, and faith formation opportunities.
  - Invest in leadership and highly competitive compensation practices that promote the recruitment and retention of exceptional and mission driven staff.

## 6. Modernize and Align Parish Facilities

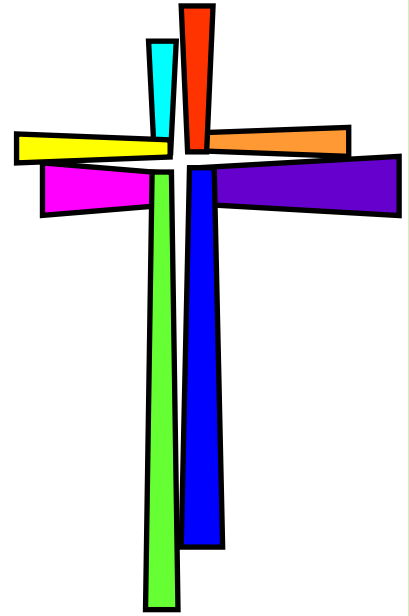
- Evaluate the rectory and school facilities to ensure they fully support ministry, education, community, and outreach services.
  - Address critical infrastructure needs, including aging mechanical systems, accessibility limitations (including lack of handicap access in key buildings such as the rectory and school), and other space constraints.
  - Create welcoming gathering spaces that foster hospitality, connection, and parish engagement.
  - Develop a long-term facilities vision that aligns with and advances the parish mission to serve both current and future generations.

## 7. Strengthen Financial Stewardship and Long-Term Sustainability

- Continue fostering a culture of stewardship within the parish community.
- Ensure transparent and responsible financial management.
- Plan thoughtfully for future ministry and facility needs.
- Encourage generous participation in supporting the mission of the parish.
