Pastor's Letter



Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

It's with great joy and humility that I introduce myself as the new pastor of St Francis Xavier Parish. My name is Fr John Chrzan, and I'm deeply honored to begin this next chapter of ministry with you in this vibrant, historic, and faith-filled community.

I was born in Kenosha, WI, and prepared for the priesthood at the University of St Mary of the Lake - Mundelein Seminary. In May, 2003, I was ordained by Cardinal Francis George, and for the past eleven years I have served as pastor of St Gilbert Parish in Grayslake. As I now step into this new role at St Francis Xavier, a parish known for its warmth and energy, generosity and strong Catholic identity, I've been reflecting on a passage from the Acts of the Apostles that I've chosen as the theme for this stage of my pastorship: "I have neither silver nor gold, but what I do have I give to you: in the name of Jesus Christ, the Nazarene, rise and walk!" (Acts 3:6)

Like Peter and John in the story from Acts, I do not bring silver or gold - but I do bring my heart, my faith, and my desire to serve. What I have, I give freely: the love of our Lord Jesus Christ, shared through Word and Sacrament, prayer and presence, service and community.

Outside of ministry, I enjoy many things that nourish my spirit: reading, history, traveling, hiking, liturgy, and ecclesiology. I am also a lifelong baseball fan - and will try to remain pastorally diplomatic about team allegiances!

I look forward to getting to know you, walking with you, and growing together in Christ. Please keep me in your prayers, as I will certainly keep you in mine.

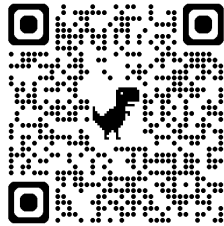

Church Audio Update Adaptive Audio System

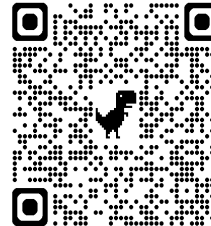

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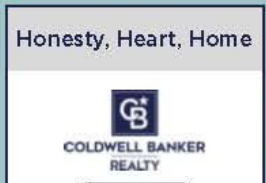
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
