# Pastor's Letter

Complete my joy by being of the same mind, with the same love, united in heart, thinking one thing.

Humbly regard others as more important than yourselves,
each looking out not for your own interests, but also for those of others.

Philippians 2:2-4

St. Paul reminds us that the *missionary disciple* brings joy into the world by proclaiming, both in word and in their relationships with others, how the death and resurrection of Jesus has transformed our world. Our witness lies not in grand gestures for all to see or in exaggerated claims of what we might do. Our witness lies in our actual, humble service of others, especially the person most in need, without regard to gender, creed, race, ethnicity, sexual identity, or social status. St. Francis Xavier Parish is blessed with a wealth of women, men, and youth who serve in large and small ways: helping others to grow in their relationship with Jesus; enhancing the vibrancy of our prayer together; and reaching out to care for those without housing or adequate food.

Each fall, the Archdiocese of Chicago presents the *Christifideles* Award to individual Catholic laypersons who have demonstrated, by participation in parish life, the personal and ministerial renewal called for by the Papal Exhortation, *Christifideles Laici*. This document called the laity to *the vocation of responsibility for the Church's life*, which springs from the gift and mission of their baptism. The pastor of each parish is asked to consult the Parish Pastoral Council and submit the names of one or two parishioners who have demonstrated such a response.

Since 2018, the PPC has built a list of *many* people who qualify for this award. The challenge is to submit only one or two names. Over the past five years, the award has been given to: Ernie and Claire Froemel, David Sherman, Elizabeth Cooley, Curt Aronson, and Laura Duelm. This Sunday at 2:00 PM, the *Christifideles* Award will be presented to our 2023 parish recipients, **Susie Lehuta and Katie McCarthy**.

Katie McCarthy has donated hundreds of hours of her time in various ministries. She has recruited and trained teen lectors and ministers of communion for the Sunday evening 5PM Mass. She has guided teen small groups in a way that helps them expand their faith on their own terms. Every Tuesday morning for the past eight years, Katie has been a dedicated and beloved volunteer at the parish Food Pantry. Earlier this year, Katie was instrumental in helping to develop an experiential series of Lenten events for hundreds of women of SFX. She helped develop our annual Living Rosary in our school parking lot, led by our elementary school students. Katie is a natural evangelizer. Her love for Jesus and her confidence in His love for her open her heart and her mind to want to help others to find Christ in their daily lives.

**Susie Lehuta** served as both a preschool aid and teacher in the parish elementary school. She has coordinated the parish lector program for several decades, and recruits, trains, and schedules women, men, and teens to serve the parish at weekend liturgies and the special celebrations of Holy Week and other prayer services. Through her efforts and skill, the scriptures are proclaimed with confidence and clarity. In addition, Susie coordinates the parish Kitchen Angels ministry, which provides home-cooked meals to parish families that are experiencing difficulties due to death, illness, or other challenges. She has been active in the annual parish retreat for women of the parish. Over her many years as a parishioner, Susie has been a key parish leader in many areas of parish life.

Congratulations, Susie and Katie! Thank you and God bless you for your witness.



# How can the Church of our time better fulfill its mission through greater recognition and promotion of the baptismal dignity of women?

Did you know that this is one of the questions Church leaders will be deliberating when they gather this October in Rome for the General Assembly of the Synod? Since the beginning of the global Synod on Synodality in 2021, the call to rethink women's participation in the Church has emerged on every continent. Moreover, according to the recently released *Instrumentum Laboris*, which sets the agenda for October's synod gathering, "Most of the Continental Assemblies and the syntheses of several Episcopal Conferences call for the question of women's inclusion in the diaconate to be considered" (B 2.3 #4). *At SFX, we discussed this topic at the three listening sessions we hosted earlier this year. Thanks again to all who participated!*




