Pastor's Letter

God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone."

Genesis 2:18

Our ancestors in faith wrote the Book of Genesis, not as a scientific documentation of how the world came to be, but as a spiritual story of the meaning and purpose behind it all. In the story of creation, God is motivated by a love that continues to expand outward. At the height of creation is humankind, to whom God entrusts the responsibility to care for all of creation. Our God, who is a communion of three distinct Persons, creates humankind in God's image: a communion of distinct beings. Man is neither to be alone nor to exist among others who all are identical to himself. Humankind is a communion of beings diverse in gender, skin tone, and ways of understanding. The binding element of our communion is the same as it is within the Trinity: a love that respects the distinctness of each person and deepens the bond that connects us all in loving care and service to one another.

As you read this, I am in final days of my annual silent retreat. I offer the remainder of this space to the parish Transition Team and encourage you to participate in the Zoom Town Hall meeting and/or the online survey, especially if you were unable to participate in one of the in-person Town Hall meetings.

HOW DO I KNOW MY RELATIONSHIP IS UNHEALTHY?


You are in an *unhealthy relationship* if you...


2024 Divorce and Beyond Support






