We are in the midst of a historical time in the Church...and SFX is a part of it!

From the Ignatian Spirituality Network...Four things we believe every Catholic should know:

- (1) We are in Synod! The Global Synod on Synodality is underway, lay people worldwide have participated as consultants to Pope Francis and there is a major assembly of bishops happening in Rome this coming October.
