

#### Pastor's Letter

"Where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

Matthew 18:20

This weekend, women of the parish invite us to reflect on the leadership role of women in the Church, as will many parishes across the Archdiocese. The Church just celebrated the Feast of St. Phoebe, a deacon of the early church referred to by St. Paul. In the early church, women often played key leadership roles, as reported in *Acts of the Apostles* and the letters of St. Paul. It also appears that *both men and women* were ordained as deacons to assist in administering the Sacrament of Baptism and for the care of the poor. Over time, the official Church suppressed the ordination of women deacons and, eventually, the ordination of men. The diaconate was restored for men over fifty years ago, following the Second Vatican Council. At the time, one bishop is said to have asked, "What about the women?" The question has yet to be answered.

A few days before I was ordained, several of my classmates and I had the opportunity to meet with a group of women who were completing the Master of Divinity program at Catholic Theological Union. The women shared their frustration at being given office clerical work during their internships, while their male counterparts were actively engaged in the pastoral and sacramental life of the Church. We responded with a commitment to open doors for them in the parishes in which we would serve and allow the people of the parish to experience the benefits of women serving in ministry alongside ordained men.

I have since had the privilege of serving on parish staffs with intelligent and compassionate women who demonstrated, through their stories and life experiences, what the Church had been missing in the limited roles open to women in church and parish life. Parishioners were able to connect with lay women and men from a faith perspective and life experience that differed from that of a male celibate. I have witnessed a woman's ability to facilitate the transformation of mind and heart through Spirit.

During my time as pastor of St. Nicholas Parish (now St. Pope John XXIII), I encouraged a group of parishioners, mostly women, who studied the theological and pastoral issues behind the possible ordination of women to the diaconate. These women were very active in parish ministry and leadership but did not feel called to pursue diaconal ministry themselves. Nonetheless, they saw the value of having the scriptures broken open from a woman's perspective and of having women serve through the various ministries of an ordained deacon. In 2013, they presented a position paper to Cardinal George, followed by a long and serious conversation that led with his commitment to present their position paper to Pope Francis. Their quiet, persistent efforts gave great hope to parishioners who feared that the institutional Church was not willing to listen.

I was encouraged recently to learn that a group had again raised the issue of the leadership role of women in the Church in connection with the Synod that will begin in a few weeks. I attended a well-attended parish listening session, with participants willing to listen and to provide feedback to the group that led the discussion. I believe that the Spirit is calling the Church to reexamine women's leadership at *all* levels of Church ministry and decision-making, and to pursue the issue of women serving as ordained deacons. I am heartened by what strong and faithful women have brought to the Church, and hopeful for how their participation may increase, here and throughout the Church.

#### **Ministry of Care is** Planning to Expand

A Minister of Care is a person who brings the gift of the eucharist and friendship to fellow parishioners and others who are homebound, living in nursing homes, or recovering in the hospital. Our visits help those in need stay connected to the parish and our faith community.

It's a very rewarding ministry and I promise you will receive more than you'll give. The time required varies depending on the activity you choose. Perhaps a few minutes or more on a homebound visit to an hour or so conducting a Prayer and Communion Service or bringing the eucharist to those in the hospital. Those visiting the homebound schedule visits convenient for the minister and the person being visited. Nursing homes and the hospital have fixed schedules.

The Archdiocese requires new ministers to receive 12 hours of instruction prior to being commissioned. After training, you will 'shadow' other ministers to learn about your chosen activity. When you are comfortable, you'll receive a quarterly schedule.

One day of training is available at LaGrange Hospital. Saturday, September 16th from 8:30am-4:00pm. Lunch Provided.



## St. Phoebe Celebration: Weekend of September 9-10

This weekend we celebrate St. Phoebe as we prayerfully listen and discern how the Holy Spirit is guiding us on the topic of women in the diaconate as part of the global Synod on Synodality.

#### This weekend, we invite those attending mass to:

- ⇒ **PRAY** through the intercession of St Phoebe for the Synod and the delegation going to Rome,
- ⇒ **CELEBRATE** women's gifts and contributions to the Church,
- ⇒ **HEAR** women of the parish reflect on scripture and
- ⇒ **BEAR WITNESS** to the critical and urgent need to re-think women's participation in the Church.



I commend to you our sister Phoebe, [diakonos] of the church at Cenchreae. Letter of St. Paul to the Romans 16:1

"Growing up, I never heard about St. Phoebe. She, like so many women of the early church, was lost to me for a long time...

Not until my late 20s do I recall Phoebe's name surfacing in my consciousness and even then, I couldn't place her beyond the heading "women of the early church." The reasons she remained in the shadows of my consciousness are as much a reflection of my own life and learning as of the institutions that have taught me and their conscious and unconscious influence on our wider perspectives as individuals and a church.

Phoebe appears in Paul's letter to the Romans, in which he exhorts the Romans: "I commend to you our sister Phoebe,

a deacon of the church in Cenchreae." Paul writes, "I ask you to receive her in the Lord in a way worthy of his people and to give her any help she may need from you, for she has been the benefactor of many people, including me" (Romans 16:1-2).

Brief though it is, this introduction is full of import. In these two verses, Paul provides critical information about the woman he has entrusted to deliver his letter to Rome.

Calling her sister, deacon and benefactor, Paul signals that Phoebe is his co-worker in the kingdom. He has chosen her to convey his message and it is his hope that they, like her, will come to believe and to support the Christian mission. By identifying Phoebe as a deacon, Paul indicates that she was a preacher and teacher of the faith and gives us the earliest written record of women's ordained ministry in the church..."




