#### **Pastor's Letter**

#### In Christ, shall all be brought to life. 1 Corinthians 15:22

Each Church year ends with the celebration of Christ as King of the Universe. We conclude our year of the gospel of Matthew with a tale of how we all will be judged at the end of time and space as we know it. Those who have spent their lives in service of the mission of Jesus by feeding the hungry, clothing the naked, caring for the sick, and visiting prisoners will be welcomed into God's kingdom; each act of kindness and mercy toward a person in need was an act of kindness directly to Christ. Those who have spent their lives focused only on their own needs learn that they have spent their lives ignoring Christ, regardless of how devoutly or frequently they "worshipped." This image summarizes much of what we have been hearing over the past few months. Our investment in bringing the message of Jesus and reaching out in love to those in need is what "builds treasure" that lasts and that deepens our relationship with Jesus.

Next Sunday is the feast day of our patron, Saint Francis Xavier. Francis was an early companion of St. Ignatius. He responded to a call to bring the message of Jesus to eastern Asia, especially Japan, India, and islands off the coast of China. Francis Xavier felt called to "set the world on fire" with the light of the Gospel and the fire of the Spirit.

For over ten years, our parish elementary school has marked our patron's feast day with a Day of Service. This Friday each grade, from pre-school through eighth grade, will spend the day in a service activity that connects to that grade's service theme for the year. Some students will go out to prepare food boxes to be sent to areas in special need; others will entertain the residents of Bethlehem Woods with BINGO and carols; others will spend time interacting with children from areas different than our own. *All* will return to share the stories of how God gifted them as they reached out to serve others.

Next Saturday, the children in our School of Religious Education will also participate in a Day of Service. Families have been offered a variety of service opportunities to share as a family. Our children model for us fitting ways to honor our patron saint by living out the gospel through service and kindness to others.

Our parish did not have an associate pastor from June 2019 – August 2020, which overlapped with the arrival of COVID. The Thursday morning Mass was replaced with praying the rosary at 8:15 AM. After recent discussions with the rosary group and others, we have decided to restore the Thursday morning Mass *beginning Thursday, December 7*. The rosary will still begin at 8:15, with Mass immediately following. All are invited to participate in either or both gatherings every Thursday.

Next Sunday is the First Sunday of Advent and the beginning of a new Church year. Free "Little Books" for Advent are now available. Advent wreath kits and prayer books are available for sale in the back of church. Tags from our annual Giving Tree will be distributed to those who want to participate in this Advent sharing program. The tag might identify a gift for a family in need, locally or on the west side of Chicago, or a way to support efforts to shelter the homeless and feed the poor. Gifts will be due the following Sunday, December 10.



#### BEWARE OF EMAIL SCAM USING PASTOR'S NAME

An email scam continues to use Fr. Bill's <u>name</u> as part of an email scam that is sent to random parishioners. This has been happening to pastors and ministers of other communities for several years. The pastor is listed as the sender with a fake (though sometimes credible) email address. An emergency request is made for money through the purchase of gift cards. If you respond, the sender asks you to reveal the PIN number on the gift card and return a picture of the card that includes the PIN. The scammer can use this information to redeem the gift cards.

Fr. Bill and the parish staff will <u>NEVER</u> make a personal request for money in this way. Requests for financial contributions to the parish or parish school will come <u>via direct</u> communication from the parish or school.
