



#### Pastor's Letter

We proclaim Christ crucified.... Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God.

1 Corinthians 1:22-23



God commands the Israelites to place love of God *above all else* and to honor the sabbath as a day to remember that <u>all</u> is a gift from God. During Lent, we open our hearts and minds to those who may work as hard or harder than we yet struggle to provide for their families. *God provides enough bounty for all* to have what they need. We who are blessed with a surplus place share in God's work when we give alms to those with less than they need. Our worship of God is not a time to place ourselves above others or to exaggerate our own worthiness apart from others. We gather for worship each week to reenter into communion with the Body of Christ in the world that our worship may lead to service.

**WORSHIP** is one more aspect of a *missionary disciple*. Much of our time in prayer may be spent in solitude, in silence, or in small groups. Yet the

culmination of our worship is *when we come together* at the tables of Word and Eucharist. We of St. Francis Xavier Parish have been blessed with the gift of an awesome house of worship that our ancestors sacrificed to build almost 100 years ago. We are blessed with a variety of talented musicians and other artists who give vibrancy and beauty to our worship. Diverse voices help the Word of God to come alive in its proclamation and application to our daily lives. Others surround us in *full, active, participation* so that our prayer to God is stronger than any one voice on its own.

And this is only the beginning. As missionary disciples, we are challenged to provide a house of worship in which each person will feel a sense of welcome; where we gather as forgiven sinners who accept our weaknesses and encourage one another to find healing in God's grace. When we leave our house of worship as missionary disciples, we share the stories of Jesus in our lives to all with open ears and open hearts. Worship that does not shape our relationships with others and lead to action on behalf of others becomes dry and hollow over time.

"We proclaim Christ crucified." St. Paul reminds us of the heart of our message. Many saw Jesus as a worker of miracles and healer of the sick. They did not want to hear his talk of being rejected by the elders and suffering death on a cross. This is the reason that Jesus, in Mark's gospel, is constantly telling those he heals not to tell others about what he has done for them. They cannot understand the depth of God's love for humankind until they have lived through the agony of the Cross that precedes the Resurrection.

Jesus chose to die that we might live. He accepted the cruelest, most humiliating death the world has offered to show example that God is with us in the midst of suffering and that God's life in us is more powerful than death. Jesus came to teach us that we are God's beloved children: those who now gather for worship and those yet to hear or experience the healing power of God's love. How will my worship this day live in my thoughts, attitudes, words, and actions as I move through this third week of Lent?

Blessings to our fourth grade children, who celebrated Reconciliation last Sunday both one-on-one and face-to-face for the first time. Blessings to all our children who are celebrating Reconciliation in these weeks, especially those preparing for First Eucharist. May we witness to them by our own example our belief in God's mercy and our desire to be reconciled continually to God and to one another.

The St Vincent de Paul Society (SVdP) is a lay Catholic organization that aspires to live the gospel message by serving Christ in the poor with love, respect, justice, hope and joy, and by working to shape a more just and compassionate society. Our SVdP Ministry assists parishioners and families and individuals in the LaGrange area when they encounter a financial hardship. In addition, SVdP meets with our clients to help them avoid a similar situation in the future by discussing their circumstances and directing them to resources in the community.

This past year, we assisted **17 families** with security deposits, property taxes, painting supplies, car insurance, cell phone bill, lodging, rent, and utility bills totaling **\$18,263**. Furthermore, we provide **\$1200** in food and gas gift cards to our Food Pantry clients and anyone in need who comes to our Rectory doors. We are grateful for your past contributions and hope you can continue to support our efforts.

## Reflection for the 3rd Sunday of Lent






As part of St. Francis Xavier school's Ignite '24






