


4th of July

This Sunday, we welcome Archbishop Fortunatus Nwachukwu. He is a bishop from Nigeria who has been appointed by Pope Francis to be the Secretary of the Dicastery for Evangelization. Archbishop Nwachukwu is a friend of Fr. Stan Ilo and is in Chicago this weekend. He asked Fr. Stan for the opportunity to celebrate Sunday Mass at an archdiocesan parish that would give him a sense of the life of the church in our archdiocese. We are honored that Fr. Stan recommended our parish, and have invited Archbishop Nwachukwu to preside and preach at the 11:00 AM Mass this Sunday. We are blessed by his presence.

Additionally, for those who recently received the Sacraments of Communion and Confirmation, we invite you and your families to join me on Sunday, June 30 from 12:30-2:30 pm at Holy Name Cathedral (735 North State Street, Chicago, IL 60654) for Sunday Mass and a Eucharistic procession. I am especially looking forward to this occasion to celebrate with the families of those young people having just received these Sacraments of Christian Initiation. Young people who are recently Confirmed and are First Communicants are welcome to wear their sacramental attire for the occasion. In addition to this material relief, the Vatican's prefect for the Dicastery for the Eastern Churches, Archbishop Claudio Gugerotti, visited Syria and Turkey to provide a ministry of presence to victims.
