Pastor's Letter

Dear friends in Christ,

With the Christmas season now behind us, we find ourselves firmly planted in Ordinary Time, steadily making our way toward Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. Outside, winter still has a firm grip on us, but even in the cold and darkness there are sure signs of hope if we know where to look. One of my favorite signs comes each year on January 21, when the Church celebrates the feast of St. Agnes.

Agnes lived at the turn of the third to the fourth century and is remembered as a courageous young martyr who bore witness to Christ during the persecutions under the Roman emperor Diocletian. According to St. Augustine and St. Ambrose, Agnes was martyred at the age of twelve. Her symbols are the palm branch of martyrdom and a lamb, an image tied to her name itself, since Agnes echoes the Latin word "agnus," which means "lamb." Each year, the Church joyfully plays with this holy word-connection in a tradition that is both ancient and charming.

On the feast of St. Agnes in Rome, two live lambs are brought to the Vatican and blessed by Pope Leo XIV. Their wool is later woven into the pallium, the distinctive vestment worn by archbishops as a sign of their pastoral office. These pallia are blessed each year on June 29, the feast of St. Peter and St. Paul, at a special mass in St. Peter's Basilica, and then given to new archbishops in their home dioceses. St. Agnes herself is even named in the Roman Canon of the Mass, a constant reminder that the witness of the saints surrounds us every time we gather at the altar.

There's another wonderful coincidence hidden in the calendar as well. The feast of St. Agnes arrives just one month after the winter solstice on December 21, meaning that the daylight has already begun its slow but steady return. At first the change is barely noticeable, but day by day the light grows stronger and the nights gradually loosen their grip. It's a beautiful image of the spiritual life: the light of Christ increasing in our hearts, often imperceptibly at first, yet faithfully and surely. Even in the heart of winter, and in the ordinary days of the Church year, God keeps his promise, leading us gently toward hope, warmth, and new life in Christ.

Ministry of Care is Planning to Expand

A Minister of Care is a person who brings the gift of the eucharist and friendship to fellow parishioners and others who are homebound, living in nursing homes, or recovering in the hospital. Our visits help those in need stay connected to the parish and our faith community.

It's a very rewarding ministry and I promise you will receive more than you'll give.

The time required varies depending on the activity you choose. Perhaps a few minutes or more on a homebound visit to an hour or so conducting a Prayer and Communion Service or bringing the eucharist to those in the hospital. Those visiting the homebound schedule visits convenient for the minister and the person being visited. Nursing homes and the hospital have fixed schedules.

The Archdiocese requires new ministers to receive 12 hours of instruction prior to being commissioned. After training, you will "shadow" other ministers to learn about your chosen activity. When you are comfortable, you'll receive a quarterly schedule.

One day training is available at LaGrange Hospital.






We are pleased to report that our partnership with Grace Lutheran for Vacation Bible School was again a great success in 2025.
