GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

1. To continue building strong relationships within our parish and beyond.

- Celebrate our similarities and differences.
- Increase involvement in small faith-sharing groups.
- Reach out with care and service to those in need.
- Reinvigorate our relationship with our sharing parish, St. Agatha.
- Collaborate with our neighboring Catholic parishes and other faith communities.

2. To celebrate meaningful worship experiences with active participation.

- Continue formation of mind, heart, and spirit within the worshipping community.
- Offer a variety of prayer experiences.
- Strengthen and increase participation in liturgical ministries.
- Continue enriching the music ministry.
- Offer practical and spiritual training and formation for liturgical ministers.

3. To provide educational, formational, and spiritual growth opportunities for all adult parishioners.

- Determine educational, formational, and spiritual needs of adults in the parish.
- Network with neighboring parishes, educational institutions, retreat centers and the Archdiocese for adult formation programs.
- Provide small group forums for exploration of spiritual experiences.
- Offer spiritual renewal opportunities to deepen people's experience of God in their lives.

4. To support education in the Catholic faith for all parish children as a sacred responsibility.

- Provide an excellent Catholic School education.
- Provide an excellent Catholic Parish Religious Education program.
- Engage the parish in the life of the school and the religious education program.
- Continue providing personal commitment and financial support for our educational programs.
- Create and maintain a physical space that inspires.

5. To engage parish teens and young adults in identifying their respective, unique needs and fostering their social, spiritual, and personal growth.

- Create a youth minister position.
- Develop a Teen Leadership Council.
- Develop a Young Adult Leadership Council.
- Facilitate service, social, spiritual and personal growth activities that engage our teens and young adults.
- Offer spiritual guidance and educational opportunities to foster a lasting Catholic identity.

6. To deepen our commitment to justice, peace, and service.

- Increase participation in outreach and the SFX Peace and Justice Committee.
- Respond to basic human needs through direct service within our parish and beyond.
- Support and deepen the parish commitment to pastoral care.
- Educate parishioners about Catholic social teaching.
- Advocate as individuals and as a parish for those in need.

7. To be good stewards of our human and financial resources.

- Create a parish culture of stewardship as a way of life — the giving of time, talent and treasure.
- Foster effective communication throughout the parish, including various forms of technology.
- Enhance lay leadership.
- Provide needed training and other resources to support parish staff and volunteers.
- Be accountable and transparent with all parish finances.

8. To maintain, enhance, and expand parish facilities.

- Develop a plan for the maintenance and enhancement of each parish facility.
- Provide space needed for all parish ministries.
- Explore the feasibility of building a parish community gathering space.
- Identify resources needed to enhance parish facilities — financial, legal, planning, design, architectural, etc.
- Consider funding options, including an Anniversary Capital Campaign, to raise needed funds.
