Dear SFX Families,

The School Advisory Board has reviewed the school operating budget for the 2022-2023 school year. This annual budget is prepared by the Parish Business Manager and School Administration. It reflects a careful balance of maintaining our high academic standards with the current economic environment. As always, St. Francis Xavier is committed to providing an excellent academic and faith-based education for **all** students who wish to be a part of our school community.

The four components of the school budget are: educational costs, tuition, fundraising, and parish subsidy. To balance our budget for the 2022-2023 school year and other expenses, our tuition rate will increase an average of 4.0%. For a one child family, this would be an increase of \$25 per month. The decision for this increase was based on an average 5% increase in faculty salaries, the reinstatement of retirement contributions which the Archdiocese suspended for the past two years, projected enrollment, and the increase to the overall operating budget.

Every year our parish provides substantial financial support to our school, recognizing that Catholic education is the largest ministry of the parish. This year is no different. We simply could not exist without this support. Last school year, the parish contributed approximately \$388,000 (23% of church offertory) to financially support the school. The parish subsidy also helps us maintain a balanced budget.

To help us better plan and budget for the beginning of the school year in August, the School Advisory Board has recommended keeping July as the due date for next year's first tuition payment. We will also continue to adhere to a parishioner / non parishioner tuition rate. At SFX we offer tuition assistance for any parents who would like their child to have a Catholic education and are not able to financially afford the entire tuition amount.
